



Music Scholarship Program

Eligibility Requirements

Dear Student of Music:

Thank you for your interest in the Associated Male Choruses of America Scholarship Program. The following explains our program and describes the parameters of scholarship eligibility.

The Associated Male Choruses of America (AMCA) Scholarship Fund was established to assist promising students of music at the undergraduate college level. It is open to all students meeting the eligibility requirements listed below.

The monetary value of the scholarship awards is based upon the funds available annually. Typically, several scholarships are awarded each year averaging between \$1000 and \$1200. All candidates must be sponsored by an AMCA member chorus.

Interested candidates must respond to an AMCA member chorus to seek sponsorship. Lists of member choruses, including contact names and telephone numbers, are available on our web site: <http://scholarship.amcof.net>. Contact the scholarship program chairman, Robert H. Torborg at the following e-mail location: scholarship@amcofa.net if you are in need of help with getting your required forms and documents.

To be eligible for consideration, applicants must meet the following requirements:

1. Be a full-time college student or entering a full-time college music program in a Bachelor's Degree curriculum.
2. Be a Music Major (vocal or choral emphasis receives preference).
3. Be sponsored by a chorus of the Associated Male Choruses of America. The applicant must perform for (solo) or with (in concert) the prospective sponsoring chorus.

All applicants must complete and/or provide the following:

- A detailed letter of support sent by the member chorus to the Scholarship Chair
- An appropriately completed application form
- An audition CD or tape cassette for voice and performance evaluation (CD preferred)
- A personal letter describing musical background, goals, and career objectives
- Three letters of personal recommendation
- A copy of the candidate's most recent course/grade transcript
